The awarding of grants is entirely at the discretion of the Overseas Relationship Team on behalf of the Council of the FIEC.  
Only those applications will be considered that are submitted using the form designed for the purpose.  
The Overseas Fellowship and Support Fund will not normally make a grant of more than 50% of the total cost of any one visit.  
FIEC cannot be held responsible in any way for the welfare of those who travel with the help of a grant from the fund. All reasonable precautions for the protection of health and safety should be taken by those who benefit from the fund and it is entirely their own responsibility.
