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Leadership in Lockdown

Under 5s

- Must be supervised by parents or guardians at church
- No provision crèche or groups
- No baby & toddler groups with parents/careers
- No mixing between households so no provision room for parents/babies

in Lockdown

Children & Youth Activities (age 5+) 1. Groups

- Groups of max 15 including supervisors
- Groups to remain separate and consistent
- Groups to maintain social distancing if possible
- Outdoor activities up to 6 from separate households



Leadership

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Children & Youth Activities (age 5+) 2. Activities

- No contact games
- No live performances including drama, comedy, music to take place in front of a live audience
- No singing, shouting, blowing instruments
- No sharing of food
- Not advised sharing of craft resources
- No overnight stays/residentials including camping

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Children & Youth Activities (age 5+) 3. Social Distancing, Hygiene & Cleaning

- Deep clean shared spaces between groups
- Different groups ideally enter/exit by different doors
- Avoid parents and children waiting
- Do not give lifts to children/young people from other households
- Young people arrive only with members their group
- Groups do not need to use separate toilets but different toilets for different groups ideal
- Toilets to be cleaned more frequently at least twice a day
- Importance of proper hand washing



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Children & Youth Activities (age 5+) 4. Preparatory Steps

- Risk assessment by senior member of staff
- Share findings risk assessment with staff and on website
- Explain to parents/careers steps taken to reduce risks in your setting
- Outline protective measures you have taken
- Keep register of children attending
