Summary:

1. To be an Outreach and Community Worker making Jesus known in Dewsbury

- 2. To enthuse, encourage and equip the whole church to love and reach out with the Gospel to the people of Dewsbury

Evangelism & mission:

- You are to seek to build contacts with people in the local community in order to share the gospel

- You are to help organise the evangelistic events of the church
- You are to help the church reach out with the gospel into the local community

Prayer:

You are to be constantly prayerful for every aspect of your work

ABOUT DEWSBURY:

Dewsbury is a post-industrial northern town of over 63,000 people. Once known for its thriving market and wool industry, it is now a spiritually needy town (46% Muslim, 23% no religion) with large areas of economic deprivation. It has good local, regional & national transport links.

ABOUT DEWSBURY EVANGELICAL CHURCH:

We have Three Loves at DEC: Love God, Love One Another, Love Dewsbury.

Affiliated with FIEC, we are a family of around 75 members ranging in age from young to, well, not so young.

Our church life is centred around Sunday services (both morning and evening), with a mid-week prayer meeting that alternates between meeting all together and meeting in small groups.

Sunday morning is a typical reformed evangelical worship service with expository preaching.

Sunday evening worship is based on a monthly rotation of different activities: Preaching; Communion; 'Dig Deeper' (a more in depth Bible study); 'Table Talk' (a topical discussion evening); a 'Missionary & Outreach Prayer Meeting', and 'Tea and Praise'

In addition, there are outreach activities for different groups, for example, 'Sharing Skills' and 'Time for a Cuppa'.

We usually hold our Christmas Carol Service in Dewsbury Town Hall.

We have an active youth work. On Sunday mornings, Bible Explorers is for children aged 3 to 11. The remainder of the youth work takes place on Fridays during term time with Good News Club for children of primary school age, followed by Friday Club for children of secondary school age.

In its time, the church has planted two sister churches, firstly, Mirfield Evangelical Church back in the late 1980s and subsequently, around ten years ago, Grace Church Wakefield.

We run an annual youth event, MaD Camp, in partnership with the churches at Mirfield and Wakefield. This takes place for one week during the summer in Wales and is always a great time, and from which the church has seen a number of conversions.
