Overview

Even though the main focus is the youth and the children's ministry we would expect and encourage the candidate to be involved in the wider church life according to their gifting.

Key Responsibilities

- Organise and Oversee Children/Youth Work: Plan, coordinate, and lead engaging programs, events, and activities aimed to draw the youth to our church and to encourage them to trust Christ and to encourage the church members to participate in youth ministry.
- Teach and Disciple: Deliver Bible-based teaching, mentor young people in their faith journey, and encourage them to apply God's Word in their daily lives.
- Develop Relationships: Build strong, Christ-centered relationships with young people, families, and church members to create a supportive and nurturing environment.
- Align with Church Vision: Work in full agreement with the church's basics of faith and demonstrate a willingness to submit to the vision and leadership of the church in accordance with God's Word.

Qualifications

- A deep love for Jesus Christ and the gospel, with a clear calling to serve God and his church.
- Agreement with the church's core beliefs and willingness to live in alignment with biblical principles.
- Strong organisational and leadership skills to effectively manage youth programs and encourage the church community to work together.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills to build meaningful connections and encourage others too.
- Humility, teachability, and submission to church leadership and vision.

Desirable:

- Previous experience in youth/church ministry
- To be willing to preach to all the congregation/lead services
