


Update on Coronavirus Law & Guidance in England



What we know

- Places of worship will open on 2nd December
- Tier 1 'Rule of 6' will apply indoors and outdoors
- Tier 2 'Household Group' inside church –
 'Rule of 6' outdoors
- Tier 3 'Household Group' inside and outdoors (except public parks etc)
- A 'unique Christmas bubble of up to 3 households can meeting indoors between 23-27 December



in Lockdown

What we know (cont.)

- Weddings with 15 attendees (Reception for 15 allowed in Tier 1 & 2)
- Funeral with 30 attendees
- Children's activities/Sunday School if COVID-Secure
- Face coverings mandatory
- Likely to last to end April
