From 29 March

- 'Stay at home' lifted but 'stay as local as possible'
- 'Qualifying groups' of max 6 people (including children) or of 2 households can meet outdoors (including private gardens)
- A 'linked childcare household' is treated as a single household
- Qualifying groups must not mix or mingle with other groups outdoors
- Organised outdoor sports (children & adults)

From 29 March (continued)

- Outdoor children's activities
- Outdoor parent and child groups (max 15 parents)
- Weddings with max 6 and funerals with max 30
- 'Support groups' of max 15 can meet indoors (but not in private premises)
- Can meet indoors for work and provision charitable services

From 29 March (continued)

- Can meet for education and training – but must be some form of accredited qualification
- Fixed penalty notices £200-£6,400 for breaching rules on gathering
- £10,000 for organising gathering of more than 30 people
- No further changes to rules on gathering expected until 17 May when will allow 6 people/2 households to meet indoors and 30 people outside
