




Q2. What other remote ministry have you provided over lockdown?








Q5. Does the current '50 cap' on attendees at Worship Services...









Challenge 1: Leading our people back

- 9 weeks of 'in person' meetings on a Sunday morning
 - 48% of our church family have attended in person on a Sunday
 - 23% of over 70's have been back
 - 28% of families returned
 - 40% of 18-30's have attended
 - 58% of asylum seekers/refugees have been back on Sunday
- Challenge of leading people is greater than anticipated

- Diagnosing the problems (Pastor's Heart Podcast)
 - Health A significant problem with health that prevents return
 - Head Anxiety, afraid to return
 - Heart Happy not to return, prefer pyjama church
- Survey to find out what people are thinking and develop appropriate pastoral responses
- Leading in faith not fear
