

#### **Societal Context**

11.9 million older people in the UK

41% of older people feel out of touch with the pace of modern life

A million+ older people go for over a month without speaking to a friend, neighbour or family member.



Over 5 million older people say that the TV or their pet is their main company

Over 1.2 million older people are **chronically** lonely

#### **God designed old age on purpose**

To radiate His graciousness and righteousness (Proverbs 4:18), to share experiences; to tell out His works (Psalm 78, 71, 145...); to teach and encourage the younger generation (Titus, Timothy).

#### Ministry with older people: How?

- Don't make digital assumptions!
- Gentle encouragement can go a long way.
- Think innovation, but keep it simple.
- Acknowledge legitimate fear





#### What is your church culture like?

- Recognising elderhood
- RAISE expectations: preach on seniors' value and purpose
- Involve as co-workers ask for their ideas for everything: outreach, prayer ministry, blessing the young...
- Enable them to 'tell out' God's faithfulness.

#### **Emerging from Lockdown: Suggestions**


- Pray!
- Encourage all in your churches to be intentional calling and visiting older friends and neighbours, bring church TO them if necessary.
- Consider inviting seniors to small Garden Gatherings to increase confidence, encourage church members to host these.
- Share 'Daily Hope' free 24/7 telephone number with seniors, especially for the those who are housebound, unable/afraid to come out to church (0800 804 8044).
- Encourage church members to accompany older members of congregation to church, to build confidence and reassure.


